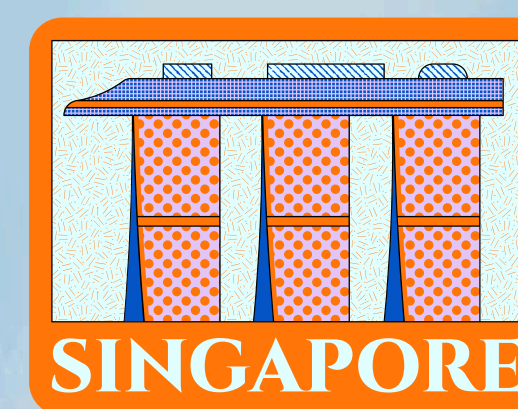

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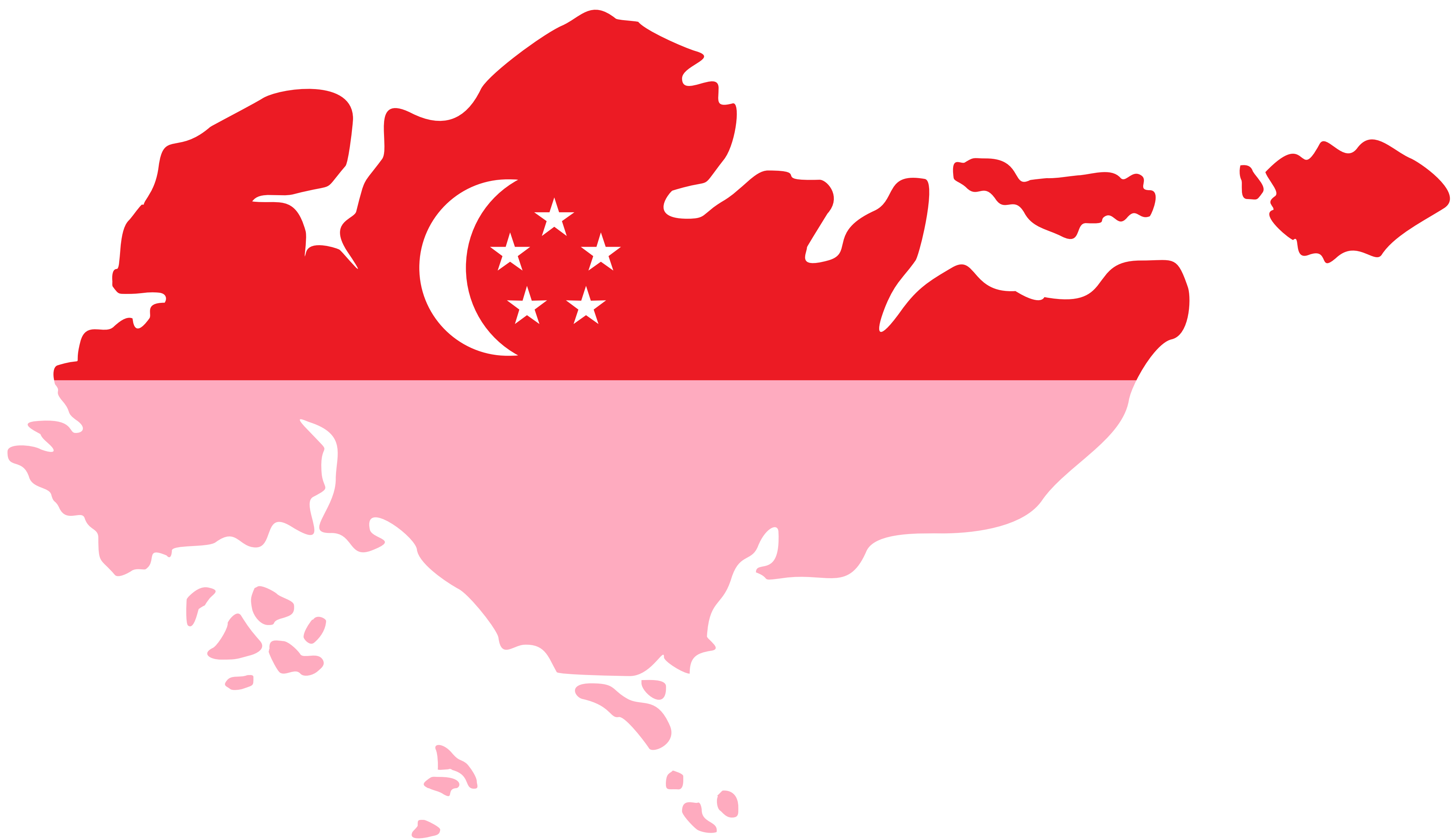

- ❤️ Free Wi-Fi is available at the airport.
- ❤️ Buy a local SIM or eSIM at the arrival hall for cheap data and calls.

Don't forget your camera or phone, this place is perfect for Instagram! Grab a laid-back bite at Satay by the Bay and enjoy garden views.






### *Tip For Family Trips*

- 🇸🇬 **Wings of Time:** Wrap up your day with a stunning night show of water, lights, and fireworks.









# SINGAPORE'S CULTURAL QUARTERS

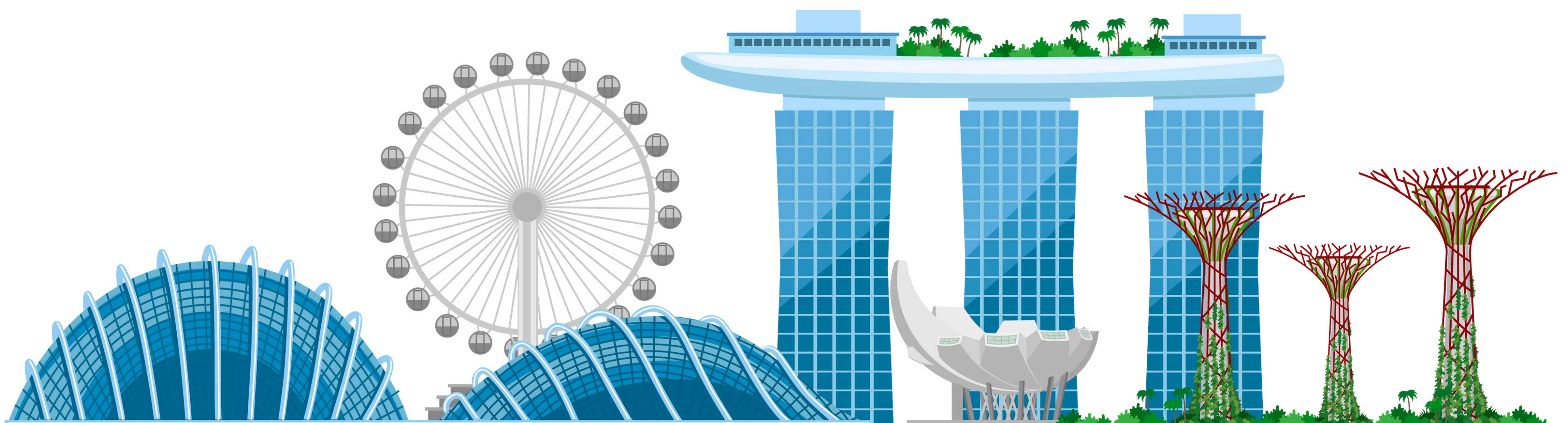
## 1. Chinatown

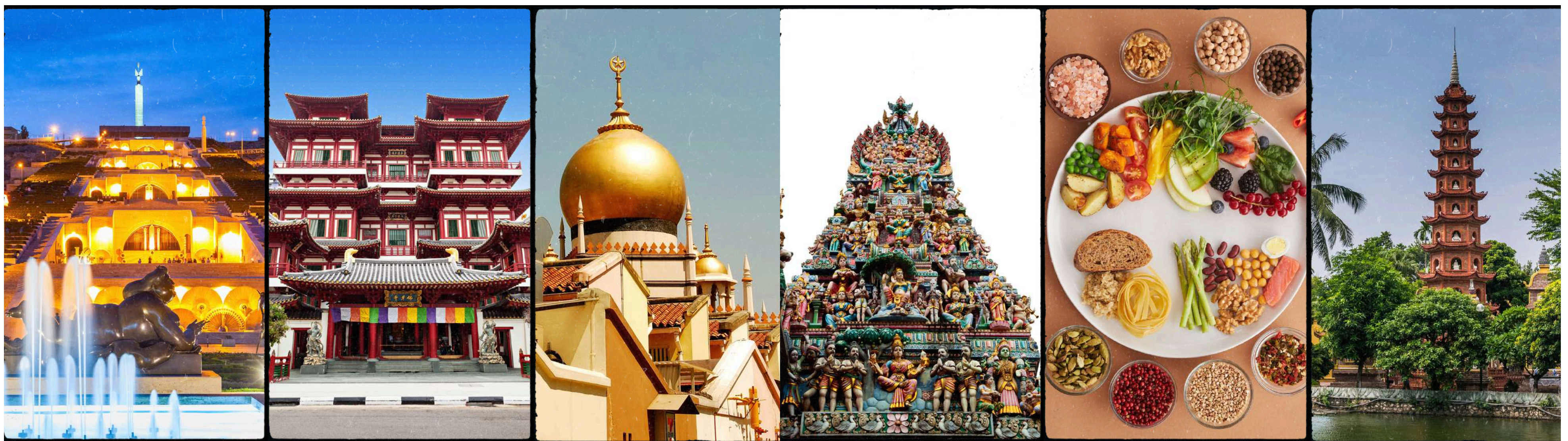






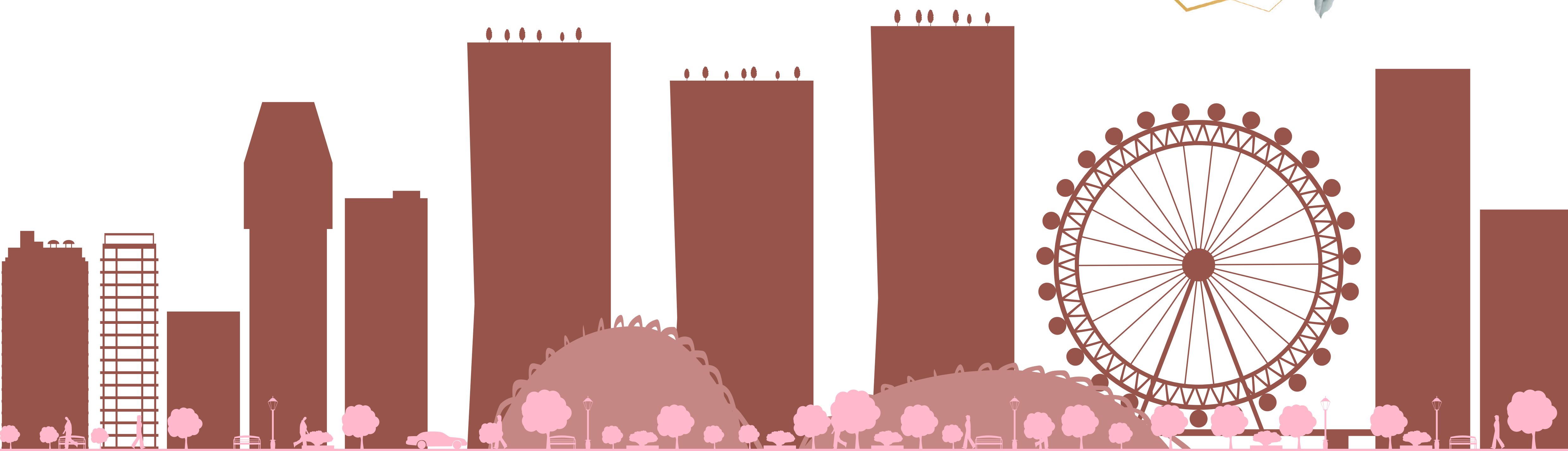
## 2. Little India

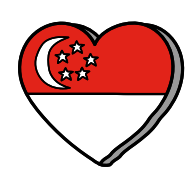

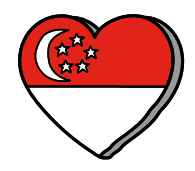
### *Tip For Solo Travelers*




### *Tip For Family Trips*

## *Avantika's Special Tip*

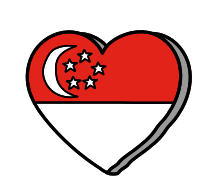
Pack a small picnic and head to the Botanic Gardens or a nearby island. It's an easy, low-cost way to enjoy nature, good food, and quiet time together.
