Carry some Thai Baht (THB) for immediate expenses on arrival. For better exchange rates, plan to convert the majority of your money once you're in Thailand.



Chapter 9: Journey's End -Phuket to Dubai




As our Thai adventure comes to a close, we took time to carefully pack our souvenirs and keepsakes. We double-checked drawers and corners before checking out of the hotel.
